The Grey Man is a registered charity specialising in the rescue and prevention of children being sold (trafficked) into the sex industry. The term “Grey Man” is used in the military to describe an operative who goes in under cover, gets the job done and retreats.

Our work is currently focused on Thailand, and the trafficking of children from neighbouring countries into Thailand. Trafficking is second only to drugs in the criminal income stakes worldwide. In Thailand children as young as twelve (in Cambodia and Myanmar as young as five) are trafficked.

Our prevention work takes the form of education and infrastructure. Currently we have a variety of projects in the north western hill tribe regions which are aimed at the prevention of trafficking by education.

We are also transporting children to schools with Thai teachers where they learn Thai (not their native language) and benefit from a general education. We are involved in programs to improve food production and health, all aimed at preventing trafficking which destroys the lives of children and their families.

We are a not-for-profit organisation and have no wages, rents and very few overheads in Australia – approximately **90% of funds raised are applied to our Asian projects**. There are other organisations and NGO agencies working with children in Thailand – however very few undertake rescues which are dangerous.
